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Relieve for villagers as Sh320m Eldoret-Iten water project is commissioned

Residents of Uasin Gishu and the neighbouring Elgeyo-Marakwet counties will benefit from access to clean and quality drinking water through conservation of water sources in the two counties.

This follows the launch of the Sh320m Global Environment Facility (GEF) funded Eldoret - Iten Water Fund project which will focus on catchment restoration, especially in areas that water to Iten and Eldoret towns emanate from.

The project, funded through the International Fund for Agriculture (IFAD) and The Nature Conservancy, falls under GEF cycle number seven projects funded by the global kitty. The entire cycle has an initial budget of Sh1.9 billion.

Environment and Forestry Principal Secretary Dr. Chris Kiptoo said, out of Sh21 billion GEF aid allocation to Kenya this year, Sh3m goes to climate change mitigation, Sh13m will go towards biodiversity while another Sh3m will go towards degraded land restoration.

Speaking at an Eldoret hotel during the official launching of the Eldoret - Iten Water Fund, Kiptoo said the project would be implemented for three years adding that apart from conservation, the project also aims at training

farmers on good agricultural practices that would not only help them improve productivity but also improve their livelihoods.

Dr. Kiptoo said Kenya has cumulatively received more than Sh120 billion since the first GEF circle to date, including Sh 900m of co-financing from other stakeholders.

The PS observed that over the past years, forest cover, especially indigenous forests, has been destroyed by human activities like indiscriminate felling of trees due to increased pressure for additional land for farming.

"This, coupled with poor farming methods and excessive use of agrochemicals, has led to soil erosion in riparian areas, leading to water contamination and pollution," said Dr. Kiptoo.

We are facing a serious crisis currently, namely climate change, pollution control, and biodiversity and nature loss, said Dr. Kiptoo who called on Kenyans to embrace serious environmental conservation and tree growing to mitigate the challenges.

Elgeyo-Marakwet Governor, Wesley Rotich, thanked the donors saying, the project, through the various partners, would be convening public, civic, and private sector entities to restore degraded land, improve management of forests and conserve riparian land.
